### **Bride & Groom Trivia**

2. If there is a period that we expect to have a lull during the dinner and before the dance, we can do the trivia as a way to keep people interacting with each other to enjoy the company.
3. If someone answers the question right at a table, they can take the centerpiece home if you wish or just have you two kiss for the winning answer.

Those are just a few ways to do the trivia game. It should be looked upon as something fun for you and your guests. Also, it's a great way to make your reception memorable and personal.
